Current students must complete the scholarship application and include their student ID number.

Returning students must complete the scholarship application and include their Midland College ID number. If students have not attended Midland College in one year they will need to complete a new application to attend Midland College.

Students must maintain a 2.5 GPA at the end of each semester for CDEC/TECA courses in order to reapply for scholarship funds.
