Midland College Baptist Student Ministry Constitution and By-Laws

Constitution

Article I—Name

The Baptist student organization of Midland College shall be called the Baptist Student Ministry, hereafter referred to as BSM.

Article II—Membership

Membership in BSM may be extended to any student expressing a desire to become a member of the organization.

Article III—Purpose

The purpose of the BSM is to provide a ministry to persons of the Midland College community, leading them toward faith in God through Jesus Christ, guiding them in Christian growth and discipleship, and involving them in responsible church membership.

Article IV—BSM Council/Leadership Team

The leadership council of BSM shall be President, Christian Growth Chairman, Christian Outreach Chairman, adult advisers, and other leaders who may be deemed necessary.

Article V—Meetings

The BSM Council shall meet at times convenient to the majority of the members. BSM shall meet as often as necessary to fulfill its purpose.

Article VI—Budget

Funding for BSM may be provided by Baptist churches directly, through the local association, and the Baptist General Convention of Texas. No dues are required for membership.

By-Laws

Article I—Elections

The leadership of BSM shall be elected annually. Nominations shall be made by a committee appointed by the president. Nominees must be current members of a local evangelical church, Baptist affiliation preferred. Election shall be by BSM membership.

Article II—Leader' Duties

The duties of the leaders shall be those agreed upon by the leaders and the volunteer BSM Director which further the mission of the organization.

Article III—Amendments

These by-laws may be amended at any general meeting of the Midland College BSM, provided the Council approves the changes, one week's prior notice is given, and three-fourths of those present and voting favors the amendment.
